



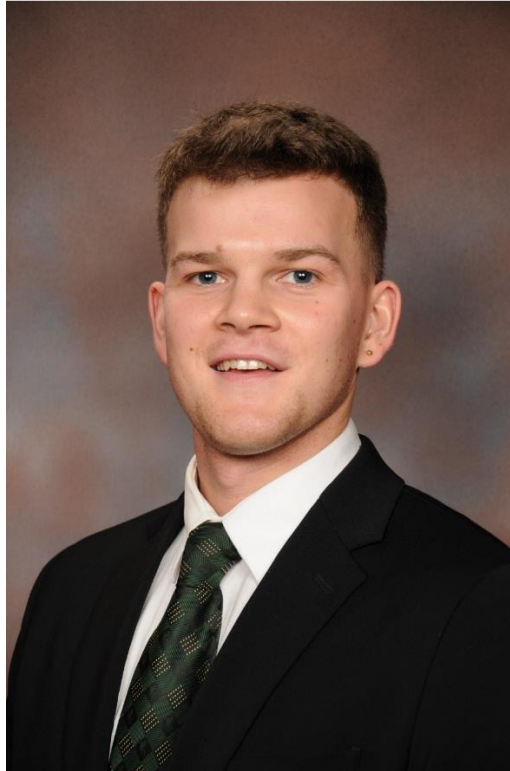

\$2,500 SCHOLARSHIP



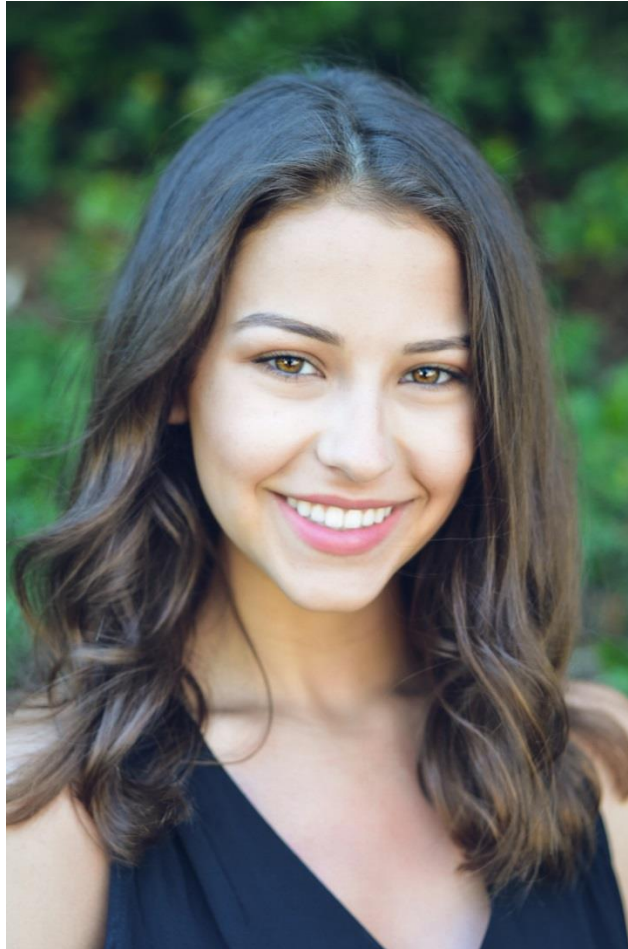

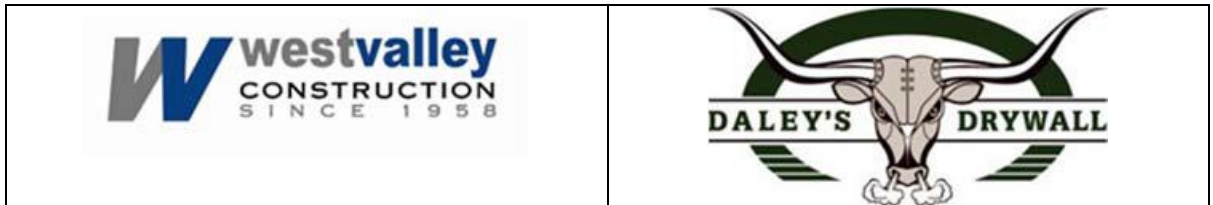
